- Update on town projects—Jeff
 - Multi-Use Trail on track for mid/late Oct completion
 - Glastonbury Blvd construction (with ped friendly improvements) on track for mid/late Oct completion
 - CRCOG grant application proceeding – if approved will fund additional cycling friendly improvements
 - The grant applications are for the Western Blvd./Eastern Blvd. connection between the two off-road trails and for the area of Main St. between School St. and New London Tpke.
 - Main St side walk construction proceeding
 - Proposal under consideration (but not funded) to have a pedestrian crossing at Main/Buttonball
 - Next spring remains target for Putnam Bridge connection
 - Awaiting input from Richard Johnson on next connection to MUT
